DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Possess ability and desire to work in camping ministry.

Ability to relate to ones peer group

Ability to accept supervision and guidance

Good character and a strong personal faith in Jesus Christ as Savior

High School Graduate and/or at least 18 years of age

RESPONSIBLE TO:

Site Director, Assistant Site Director, and/or Event Director

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

It will be the responsibility of the Core Staff to work for the Site during the day and provide a 2nd adult presence in the sleeping areas of the camp during the nighttime hours.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1.) Work for the Site during the day in one or more of the following areas as assigned and on a weekly rotating schedule
 - a. Dish room crew
 - b. Grounds maintenance
 - c. Custodial cleaning
 - d. Lifeguarding and Pool cleaning
 - e. Initiatives course facilitator
 - f. Archery instruction
- 2.) Provide supervision as 2nd adult presence in sleeping areas at night to assure that risk management and Site policies and procedures are followed
- 3.) Core staff will be responsible for additional duties as assigned by the Site Director or Assistant Site Director.

WORK CONDITIONS:

1. Employment will run from May 21st through August 3rd 2018.
2. Salary for summer will be \$2,000 plus meals and lodging.
3. Core Staff paid 1st and 15th of every month until completion of employment.
4. Core Staff will be trained in all areas of specialty such as Lifeguarding and Initiatives course facilitating.
5. Core Staff will receive one week off during the summer, to be scheduled by the Site Director according to convenience.
6. Work week will run from Sunday 9pm until Saturday 12 noon.
